Description of Incident:

The Cheshire Fire Department responded to a reported structural fire at 110 Mayview Ave. Upon arrival a well-involved structure fire was found on the second floor of a two-story wood framed residence. Firefighters extinguished the fire in approximately fifteen minutes. There were four occupants home at the time of the fire who escaped without injury; The involved structure sustained major damage and much of the contents were destroyed. Several pets were saved in the fire. The occupants are being housed temporarily by the Cheshire Human Services Department. Response time was approximately seven minutes, no injuries were reported.
